NORTH LITTLE ROCK, Ark. (March 20, 2020). Mayor Joe Smith, in keeping with keeping Governor Asa Hutchinson’s recommendation, is mandating the closing of restaurants and bars across the city of North Little Rock for dine-in service. Carryout, curbside pickup, and delivery will be allowed to continue and are encouraged. Mayor Joe Smith also has announced the closing of the lobbies of City Hall and City Services. The Police Headquarters will be closed except for the front desk. This will not affect police patrols or services. This is an effort to curtail the spread of the virus in North Little Rock and protect city workers and its citizens. Beginning at noon today, offices will be closed and services will be done by the drive-through in the case of City Services, online, and by phone until further notice.
