A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING APPRECIATION TO THE GLOVER FAMILY FOR THE DONATION OF THEIR INTEREST IN THE ROCK ISLAND BRIDGE MADE FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE CITY OF NORTH LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, on November 1, 2002, Roy and Rosemary Glover donated their interest in the Rock Island Bridge to ensure its development by the Clinton Foundation; and

WHEREAS, the donation of their interest was vitally important to the success of the Clinton Presidential Library and its connectivity to the City of North Little Rock (“the City”); and

WHEREAS, the Glover Family has provided longstanding service to the North Little Rock community, and the City wishes to gratefully acknowledge and commemorate the Glover Family for the donation of their interest in the Rock Island Bridge with a monument to be erected at the foot of the bridge as depicted on Exhibits “A”, “B” and “C” attached hereto.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1: That the North Little Rock City Council hereby expresses its sincere appreciation and gratitude to the Roy and Rosemary Glover Family for their service to the City of North Little Rock and donation of their interest in the Rock Island Bridge.

SECTION 2: That in order to acknowledge and commemorate the contributions of the Glover Family, a monument will be erected, at no expense to the City, at the foot of the Rock Island Bridge as described and shown on Exhibits “A”, “B” and “C” attached hereto.

SECTION 3: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.






DESCRIPTION OF GLOVER FAMILY MONUMENT

The monument will be made of grey marble and will sit atop a concrete or other masonry pad which will have concrete footings sufficient to support the monument. The front edge of the pad on which the monument sits will be situated a distance of approximately 8 feet west of the sidewalk and the center of such pad will be situated a distance of approximately 16 feet north of the end of the handrails at the foot of the Rock Island Bridge as depicted on Exhibit B. The eastern face of the monument, which shall be three feet high and five feet wide, shall bear the inscription set forth on Exhibit A and may later include any commemoration date. The stone shall have the general shape and dimensions as follows shown by side view (though this drawing is not to scale):


