VOTE: Budget revision for The One, Inc., to purchase \$4,000 refrigeration unit with Fit 2 Live funds instead of the more expensive unit that was originally proposed. Bernadette Rhodes made motion to approve, Dan Scott seconded. Motion passed unanimously.

VOTE: Budget revision for FFIC Food Forest to use remaining \$2,600 to hire consultant to create feasibility/implementation plan for Food Forest instead of using Fit 2 Live funds for implementation without a plan. Dan Scott made motion to approve, Dawn Smith seconded. Motion passed unanimously.
