April 20, 2015 Meeting Minutes

The meeting came to order at 6 pm.

The Whitings presented an application to beautify the Indian Hills Fire Station. After discussion, Bubba Earnhart made a motion to fund the application for \$2319.19. Susan Langley seconded the motion. It passed unanimously.

An application from Military Heights to plant trees in the Military Heights Park was discussed. The application requested more money from the City Beautiful Commission than was matched in the request. Dan Scott pointed out that they had not included a \$1000.00 Ward Beautification grant for a bench for the park the neighborhood association had received and that would put them above the matching amount required. After discussion, Susan Langley made a motion to approve Military Heights from the requested \$2860.00. Betsy Davies seconded the motion which passed unanimously. Staff was requested to remind the Military Heights neighborhood group that the planters funded last year need to be maintained. Staff was also requested to contact the Parks Department and ask them if they would water the trees once planted.

The meeting adjourned at 7 pm.
