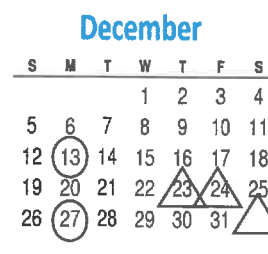

A staff member will get your name. You will then be muted and participate in the meeting by listening until your application is called. If there are any questions about your application, you will be unmuted and given the opportunity to speak.

Any one who wishes to speak on the agenda virtually, during any scheduled public hearings, or during public comment may do so by either:

- (1) **Emailing the North Little Rock City Clerk's office** at CityClerkOffice@nlr.ar.gov, by 4:00 p.m. prior to the meeting. **Emails sent** to the City Clerk will be read at the meeting.
- (2) Or, **call 501-500-0955 between 5:15 p.m. and 5:45 p.m.** Enter the **meeting ID: 149 511 1456**. When prompted for the participant ID, press # or wait. A staff member will get your name, address, telephone number and the item you wish to speak on, if applicable. You will then be muted and participate in the meeting by listening until the item you signed up to speak on is called, or until the public comment portion of the meeting. At that time, you will be unmuted and given the opportunity to speak.


