Senior Citizens Commission Meeting Minutes for **October 24, 2016**

New Business: Tickets for the NLR Woman's Club Carousel Ball. Robert Barnes made a motion to purchase 10 tickets. Dick Giddings seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Program Update: The commissioners received a written program update from Mr. Baxter dated October 24, 2016. Mr. Baxter supplemented the report with the following discussion:

- 1) The Senior Citizens Outreach Commission met and approved the sale of vans #4 and #5. In addition to the vans, various outdated equipment will be placed on the website for auction.
- 2) Nine volunteers celebrated milestones with lunch at Charlotte's in Keo.
- 3) Member Mike Miller is a championship pole vaulter for the Sr. Olympics.
- 4) Mr. Witcher asked about the flea market. Mr. Baxter stated it is gone and the funds are in the Sr. Citizen's Outreach 501(c) 3 bank account.
- 5) Dick Blankenbeker inquired about the telephone system. Mr. Baxter replied it is going well except for the announcement system.
- 6) Virginia Raum asked about the water leak. Mr. Baxter stated that ever since Robert Barnes put in the door to watch for the leak, it hasn't leaked.
