

RESOLUTION NO. _____

A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE 2023 BUDGET AND APPROVING RETROACTIVE SALARY INCREASES FOR THE PERIOD OF MARCH 31, 2023 TO MAY 26, 2023 FOR FULL-TIME EMPLOYEES AND PART-TIME EMPLOYEES OF THE NORTH LITTLE ROCK ELECTRIC DEPARTMENT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, City Council has found and determined that it is necessary and desirable to amend the 2023 Budget (adopted pursuant to Resolution No. 10426 on November 14, 2022 and Resolution No. 10507 adopted on March 13, 2023) to authorize a retroactive 2.0% pay increase for all full-time employees and part-time employees of NLRED for the period March 31, 2023 to May 26, 2023 and include these additional expenditures for NLRED.

WHEREAS, the City Council recognized the extraordinary contributions of NLRED employees during the historic tornado event that impacted the City beginning on March 31, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the salary increases for the employees identified above should be made retroactive from March 31, 2023 to May 26, 2023; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the citizens and residents of the City of North Little Rock that such retroactive pay be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1: That the 2023 Budget for NLRED should be, and is hereby, amended to include additional expenditures for NLRED as listed below:
