- SECTION 2: That the City Attorney for the City of North Little Rock is hereby granted a 2% increase in base salary, effective March 31, 2023.
- SECTION 3: That the City Clerk/Treasurer for the City of North Little Rock is hereby granted a 2% increase in base salary, effective March 31, 2023.
- SECTION 4: That the Council Members for the City of North Little Rock are hereby granted a 2% increase in base salary, effective March 31, 2023.
- SECTION 5: That the salary increases contemplated by this Resolution are subject to and contingent upon the appropriation of sufficient funding by City Council to be included in a 2023 budget amendment.

SECTION 6: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
