## ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE REZONING CERTAIN PROPERTY LOCATED AT 100 CAMPBELL ROAD IN THE CITY OF NORTH LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS, FROM R2 AND I2 TO I2 ZONING CLASSIFICATION, BY AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 9263; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, application was duly made by Brian Dale on behalf of Joe White and Associates, 25 Rahling Circle, Suite A-2, Little Rock, Arkansas 72223, seeking a rezone of the herein described land to allow a glass recycling facility on certain real property located at 100 Campbell Road, which application was duly considered and approved (5 affirmative votes; 2 against; 2 absent) by the North Little Rock Planning Commission at a regular meeting thereof held on August 8, 2023.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1: That Ordinance No. 9263 of the City of North Little Rock, Arkansas ("the Zoning Ordinance") is hereby amended by changing the classification of certain land from R2 and I2 to I2 zoning, said property being located at 100 Campbell Road in the City of North Little Rock, Pulaski County, Arkansas and more particularly described as:

BLOCKS 1, 3 AND 4 OF JOHN DOUGLAS ACRES, BEING A SUBDIVISION OF THE EAST 1/2 OF SPANISH GRANT #2418, IN T-1-N, R-11-W; PULASKI COUNTY, ARKANSAS. LESS AND EXCEPT THE NORTHERN 700' OF SAID BLOCK 1 (See maps collectively attached hereto as Exhibit A)

SECTION 2: That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

SECTION 3: That the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable and if any section, phrase or provision shall be declared or held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the remainder of the sections, phrases or provisions.


