Dear Mayor Hartwick;

On May 5, 2023, North Little Rock Code Enforcement Officer Timothy McEuen began an investigation into 819 N. H Street due to observed conditions of the property.

Officer McEuen verified the property was vacant so he performed an exterior inspection of the property. Officer McEuen observed major damage to the roofing, siding, soffit, and fascia. After no response from the owner of record, an administrative search warrant was obtained for the purpose of an interior inspection. The interior inspection showed major damage to the Ceilings, floors and walls, with the observed damage, this property is considered unfit for human habitation.

On May 8<sup>th</sup>, 2023, Officer McEuen posted a *Notice of City Council* hearing on the property, and mailed them out to all known owners and heirs. To date, the property is still in the same condition it was when the investigation began.

The condemnation proceedings were started due to the condition of the house. Owners and/or heirs and all interested parties were given notice of City Council for the August 28<sup>th</sup>, 2023 hearing date. Notices were mailed by certified and regular mail, legal notice ran in the newspaper, and were also posted on the property.

This property constitutes a public nuisance; it is the recommendation of the North Little Rock Code Enforcement Department that this structure be considered for condemnation.

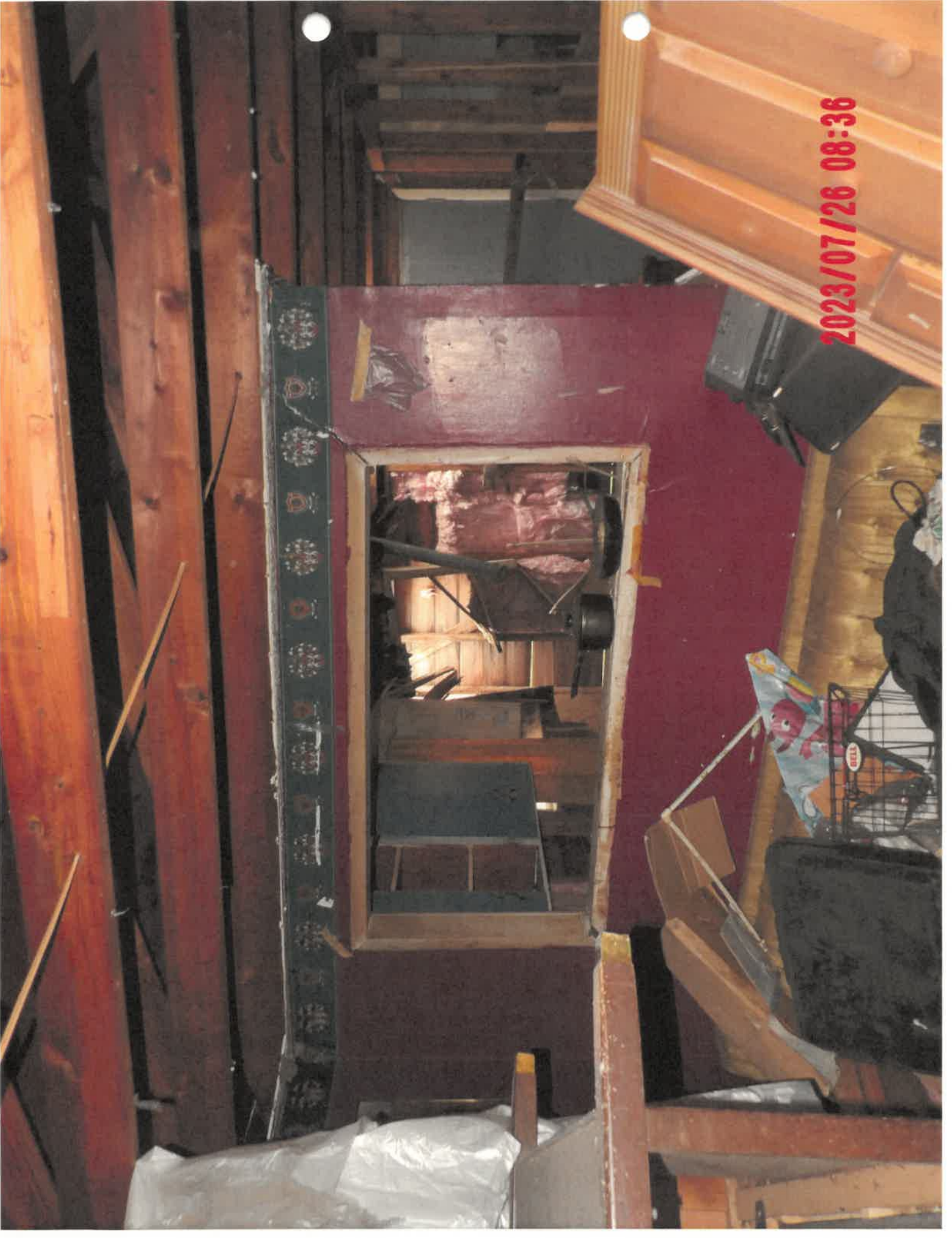
