## Juvenile Curfew Ordinance Sgt. Amy Cooper, NLRPD

As we enter the final weeks of the school year and are looking ahead to the lazy days of summer, your North Little Rock Police Department would like to remind its citizens about the Juvenile Curfew Ordinance (Ordinance #8098). In the City of North Little Rock it is unlawful for a juvenile age seventeen (17) or younger to be out on the streets and sidewalks of this city during designated curfew hours. The curfew hours for weekdays (Sunday through Thursday) are 10:00pm to 5:00am. The curfew hours for Friday and Saturday are 12:00 midnight until 5:00am. This Ordinance was designed to ensure the protection and safety of the youth of this community. It is also important to note that the Curfew Ordinance goes further and advises that the parents/guardians of the juvenile shall not permit the juvenile to be out after curfew unless there is a situation that requires the juvenile to be out after curfew. Those situations would be looked at on a case by case basis.

When a police officer encounters a juvenile who is found in violation of the Curfew Ordinance the officer will make contact with the juvenile's parents or guardians and take the juvenile home if possible. For the first offense the juvenile and his/her parent or guardian will be issued a Curfew Violation Report form that both the juvenile and the parent/guardian will sign. Subsequent violations by the juvenile could result in fines for the parent/guardian and go up to notification of the juvenile authorities and potential prosecution for the parent/guardian.

If a citizen happens to observe a juvenile who is thought to be in violation of the Juvenile Curfew Ordinance he or she may contact the North Little Rock Police Department non-emergency number (501-758-1234) and report the observation. A few things to remember if reporting a possible curfew violation are the gender and race of the juvenile, location where the juvenile was observed, a clothing description, and an approximate age. This information will be helpful for officers responding to the area as they attempt to locate the juvenile.

We at your North Little Rock Police Department value each and every one of our citizens. Your safety and quality of life is of the upmost importance to us. We hope that you all have a wonderful and safe start to the summer.

#### **Vote May 22, 2018**

The Preferential Primary and Nonpartisan General Election will be held on May 22, 2018 with polls open from 7:30 AM to 7:30 PM. This is an election that decides which Democratic and which Republican candidates move on to the general election on Tuesday, November 6, 2018. But this election does much more than that: It also is the actual election for nonpartisan races i.e. electing judges. Judicial races will only show up on the November ballot if no candidate receives a majority of the ballots in this election. In that case, the November election will contain a runoff for that judicial position.

According to the Pulaski County Election Commission website (http://www.votepulaski.net/Elections/2018/05222018PrefPrimary/notice of election final.pdf) there are eleven contested positions on the Democratic ballot and four contested positions on the Republican ballot. Nonpartisan races on this ballot are for State Supreme Court Associate Justice Position 3 and State District Court 31, Little Rock Position 1. Although the title of the District Court position says "Little Rock" it is filled by a county-wide election.

Early voting is available in North Little Rock at the Laman Library at 2801 Orange Street from May 7 to May 19. Polling hours are Monday to Friday from 10 AM to 6 PM and on Saturdays from 10 AM to 4 PM. Early voting is also available at the Pulaski County Regional Building at 501 W. Markham in Little Rock. Voting will be held there May 7- May 19 from 8 AM to 6 PM Monday through Friday, and 10 AM to 4 PM on Saturdays. You may also vote at the PC Regional Building from 8 AM to 5 PM on Monday, May 21, 2018.

#### \*\* New Voter ID Requirement Effective August 1, 2017 \*\*

Voters at the polls must show "Verification of Voter Registration", which is a document or identification card issued by the **United States**, the **State of Arkansas**, the **County Clerk** or an **accredited postsecondary educational institution in the State of Arkansas** that shows the **name** and **photograph** of the person to whom it was issued.




## Candidate Forum on May 1, 2018
