ordinance no. 8407

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 7598 WHICH ESTABLISHED PROCEDURES FOR THE RENAMING OF STREETS IN THE CITY OF NORTH LITTLE ROCK; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 7598 adopted October 27, 2003, the North Little Rock City Council established procedures for the renaming of streets within the City; and

WHEREAS, in order to avoid renaming a street whose name has historical significance to the City and its residents, it is necessary to amend the procedures for renaming a street to include researching the origin of the street's name.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1: That the procedures for the renaming of streets within the City of North Little Rock, Arkansas are hereby amended as follows:

PROCEDURES FOR RENAMING OF STREETS:

- 1. Any citizen who desires to circulate a petition for the renaming of a street may obtain a eopy of such a petition Petition to Rename Street form from the City Clerk's office. The proposed new name for the street will be entered on the petition, and the petition will be given to the City Clerk's office.
- 2. The City Clerk's <u>eOffice</u> will date stamp the petition when received and forward a copy to the Police <u>Department</u>, Fire <u>Department</u>, Planning <u>Departments and</u>, 911 Communications Center and History Commission for review. Upon receiving receipt of the proposed petition, these <u>Police</u>, Fire, <u>Planning and 911</u> departments shall review the same and return their replies to the Office of the City Clerk within ten (10) days forward any objections to the office of the City Clerk indicating any objections. The History Commission shall research the origin of the current name of the street and advise the City Clerk's Office of any historical significance, if available, of the current street name.
- 3. If no objections are received, the petition (including notation of any historical significance of the current street name) must then be circulated to affected property owners who will indicate whether they are for or against the renaming. All reasonable efforts will be made to obtain signatures of all affected property owners. The petition shall contain at least one point of

contact and shall be filed with the offices of the City Clerk and Planning Department.

- 4. Community Planning will then submit the paperwork to the City Attorney's office for preparation of legislation.
- 5. Once legislation is filed, the City Council shall hold a public hearing no sooner than the next council meeting before taking a vote.

SECTION 2: That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

SECTION 3: That the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable and if any section, phrase or provision shall be declared or held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the remainder of the sections, phrases or provisions.

SECTION 4: That the North Little Rock City Council has found and determined that the provisions of this Ordinance are immediately necessary in order to insure the proper and orderly growth and development of this land and of the City of North Little Rock, Arkansas, assuring that proper procedures are in effect for renaming streets within the City and that all parties are aware of any historical significance of a current street name; THEREFORE, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
