On or around October 5<sup>th</sup>, 2022, North Little Rock Code Enforcement Officer Timothy McEuen began an investigation into 800 N. Beech Street Building 8 due to the structure being damaged by fire. Officer McEuen posted a "red tag" on the structure due to it being damaged to the point it was no longer fit for human habitation. North Little Rock Code Enforcement Director Felecia McHenry was in contact with the owners the lending company and the insurance company regarding a dispute of the release of funds. All parties were advised the City would move forward with the condemnation of the building.

On August 25<sup>th</sup>, 2023, Officer McEuen posted a *Notice of City Council Hearing* on the property due to it being in the same condition it was when the investigation began.

The condemnation proceedings were initiated due to the condition of the structure. Owners and/or heirs and all interested parties were given notice of City Council for the November 13<sup>th</sup>, 2023 hearing date. Notices were mailed by certified and regular mail, legal notice ran in the newspaper, and were also posted on the property.

This property constitutes a public nuisance; it is the recommendation of the North Little Rock Code Enforcement Department that this structure be considered for condemnation.
