<b>Community Garden &amp; Funds</b>	<b>Notes</b>
Veterans Trail Garden - <b>\$0</b>	This garden is new to the network. They did not apply for funds, but wanted to join the program.
St. Joseph Center- <b>\$4,430</b>	Full approval, except for the \$250 "Soil Amendments" request. The Community Garden Program will work with the NLR Street Department to get large loads of soil/mulch delivered to gardens, free of charge.
Skyline- <b>\$900</b>	Full approval for their application. They have been a long-time member of the program, and have requested a small budget for repairs to raised beds.
Iris Park- <b>\$5,000</b>	Full approval for their application - pending the notion that if not all funds are spent on the irrigation project, the funds will either be a) returned to the program's budget or b) used for other on-site garden projects.
Dark Hollow - <b>\$3,008</b>	Full approval for their application. The riding lawn mower is necessary for the size of the garden, and abilities of gardeners. There was concern over the "Mowing Lawn" request, but it will be used to cover gas money.
North Heights- <b>\$830</b>	Full approval for their application. It was precise and thorough - they have plans to build new beds, and repair the older ones.
Shiloh Baptist Church- <b>\$4,200</b>	Full approval, except for the \$800 "Patio w/ Covering" request. Under the "Assurances - Unallowable Expenses" section of the application, decorative structures are not to be funded via the program.
