A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF NORTH LITTLE ROCK FOR 2024 TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES PROGRAM (TAP) GRANT FUNDS FOR THE CRYSTAL HILL REALIGNMENT PROJECT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of North Little Rock (“City”) is improving and extending Crystal Hill Road from the North Little Rock/Maumelle city limit to Maumelle Boulevard at Corporate Drive (hereafter “Crystal Hill Road Realignment Project”); and

WHEREAS, the City desires to apply for TAP grant funds for the creation of a shared path used by pedestrians and bicycles along Crystal Hill Road, and understands it will be responsible for a 20% local matching share if the TAP grant funds are awarded to and accepted by it.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor is hereby authorized to submit an application on behalf of the City of North Little Rock for grant funding from the Arkansas Department of Transportation’s Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) for the creation of the pedestrian/bicycle path as part of the Crystal Hill Realignment Project.

SECTION 2: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
