ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING A CONDITIONAL USE TO ALLOW OUT-PATIENT REHABILITATION IN AN 12 ZONE FOR CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY LOCATED AT 4900 NORTHSHORE LANE IN THE CITY OF NORTH LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, application was duly made by Anthony Lynch of LFG Recovery LLC, 23 Bradbury Drive, Little Rock, Arkansas 72212, seeking a conditional use for property located at 4900 Northshore Drive to allow out-patient rehabilitation in an I2 zone, which application was duly considered and approved (8 affirmative votes; 1 absent) by the North Little Rock Planning Commission at a regularly scheduled meeting held on July 9, 2024.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1: That a Conditional Use is approved for out-patient rehabilitation in an I2 zone for the subject real property located at 4900 Northshore Lane in the City of North Little Rock, Pulaski County, Arkansas, being more particularly described as follows:

LOT 6R, BLOCK 8 OF THE NORTHSHORE BUSINESS PARK ADDITION TO THE CITY OF NORTH LITTLE ROCK, PULASKI COUNTY, ARKANSAS (See map and drawing attached collectively hereto as Exhibit A.)

SECTION 2: That this Conditional Use shall be subject to the following:

- 1. No overnight stay will be provided.
- 2. The hours of operation hours 6 am 8 pm Monday Saturday.
- 3. The Fire Marshal must approve the use of the facility as proposed. The applicant must provide written approval from the Fire Marshall's office along with an inspection report prior to the issuance of a zoning certificate for a business license.
- 4. All structures on the site shall meet all applicable Federal, State, County and City requirements and codes.
- 5. A business license is to be issued after Planning Staff confirmation of requirements.
- 6. Business license holder understands the failure to comply with these conditions may result in loss of the Special Use approval and/or loss of Business license and/or removal of electric power meter.

SECTION 3: That all ordinances or parts of ordinance in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

SECTION 4: That the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable and if any section, phrase or provision shall be declared or held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the remainder of the sections, phrases or provisions.





Offin Map





Conditional Use # 2024-12






Zonfing Map

We believe that this will contribute to accessible care and treatment for those suffering from a substance abuse disorder.
