Just to follow up from the crime watch regarding the subject address, I've met face to face with the owner and have gotten a signed request from him to Enforce Criminal Trespass and clarifying who is supposed to be on the property or not.

Since then, we've issued 5 Criminal Trespass Warnings, made one felony arrest, and I personally have investigated the maroon Dodge pickup, successfully identified the owner, and even searched the truck to look for signs of contraband. At this time, I found no evidence that the truck in question is involved in any large scale dealing, but either way he also has been warned and removed from the property.
